SUBJECT: Evening Commission Meetings

The draft resolution for Item G-3 on the June 8, 2021 Agenda provides for evening meetings commencing at 5:00 p.m. for certain zoning issues and other issues of great public importance. Our city is largely comprised of working families who are unable to take off work to attend commission meetings. Aside from Coral Gables, out of the 33 other municipalities, only four (4) do not hold evening meetings: Miami, Miami Beach, Doral (zoning items are scheduled in the evening), and Indian Creek (population of 86, including 4 of the Forbes 500 richest people in America.
